As per the directions of Supreme Court of India, ragging within or outside any educational institution is prohibited.

- **“Ragging” means doing an act which causes or is likely to cause insult or annoyance or fear or apprehension or threat or intimidation or outrage of modesty or injury to a student.**
- **The punishment meted out would be exemplarily and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.**
- **In case any student is found to be indulging in ragging or if it is noticed later that he/she has indulged in ragging he/she shall be expelled from the educational institution.**
- **Anti-ragging committee and squads have been formed to ensure that there is no deviation in the recommendations of Hon.Supreme Court.**

Acts amounting to ragging could be

- **Teasing, Embarassing and Humiliating**
- **Assaulting or using criminal force or criminal intimidation.**
- **Wrongfully restraining or Confining, of causing hurt.**
- **Causing grievous hurt, kidnapping or rape or committing unnatural offence.**
- **Causing death or abetting suicide.**

Ragging is a criminal offence as per the law and consequences would be

- **Rustication from the college**
- **Embossment on Marksheets, degree certificate etc. stating that he/she indulged in Ragging**
- **Penalty and imprisonment upto 3 years**
- **Fine of Rs.25,000/-**
