Event Description

IEEE India Council and IEEE Hyderabad Section conducted a three day program called All India Student Young Professional Women in Engineering Congress 2019(AISYWC'19) during 28th-30th September 2019 at CMR Group of Institution, Hyderabad.

The program first started with inauguration and a small overview of the congress. Then a keynote address was given by Dr. GVV Sharma, Assoc. Professor at IIT Hyderabad. He talked about 'DSP through Digital Filtering', how DSP can be correlated with Image processing. The second seminar was on 'IEEE Microwave Theory and Techniques' by Dr. N Srinivasa Rao, the treasurer of IEEE Hyderabad Section. The third seminar was on 'Importance of research in RF and Microwave Engineering' by Dr Sulakshana Chilukuri, Assoc. Professor at Vardhaman College of Engineering. Later, Murali Bukkapatnam spoke about Entrepreneurship in Global Perspective. The final seminar was on 'Failures, Learning and Experiments: Achieving something Meaningful' by Puneet K Mishra. In the evening, Award and Cultural night was organized in which the recipients of the IEEE grants were awarded. After this, the Hyderabad section members performed cultural events, showcased their talents and ended the session by thanking all the members.

The following day, the first seminar was conducted by Prof. Sandhya Kode, the Director and Training and Development member of IIT Hyderabad. She spoke on the topic 'Obstacle or Opportunity?' and how obstacles can be viewed as opportunities. The second seminar was on 'Digital Wellbeing', conducted by Mr. Anil Rachamall, the founder of End Now Foundation and a Social Activist. He enlightened the members about how social media is marring people's social skills and hinders their day to day activities. Later, there was a panel discussion on 'Future of Employment: Employee vs Entrepreneur vs Consultant', where Mr. Sudeendra Koushik, Mr. K.Gopalakrishna, Dr. Amit Kumar and Mr. J.Krishnaswamy were the panelists and Mr. Abhishek Appaji was the moderator.

A small sessions on 'AI for Social Good' by Dr. Atul Negi and 'Wi-Fi Connectivity for Remote Sensing Drones' by N Venkatesh were held. The day-2 program came to an end with the performance of cultural events where the participants were from all IEEE sections.

On the last day, the first seminar was conducted by Mr. Abhishek Appaji, and Mr. Vamsi Krishna, on 'Crossing the Chasm from Student to Studentpreneur', where they spoke about the students who become entrepreneur at a young age. The next seminar was on 'Make A Difference (MAD)' conducted by Prof. ML Sai Kumar, Past Dean of Academics, and Institute of Public Enterprise. The last session was an icebreaking one, where the host talked about IEEE Collabratec, an integrated online community where technology professionals can network, collaborate, and create an all in one central hub. The session came to an end with Valedictory and taking Group photos of all the IEEE section members.
