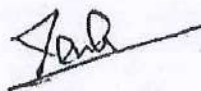

- d. Sharing the shortlisted report with the Donor for approval and clarifications, if any.
- e. Awarding the Scholarship Amount to the selected students and getting the Scholarship Undertaking form duly filled & signed by the selected students to agree to the conditions of the Scholarship.
- f. The process for shortlisting of candidates shall happen every year and scholarship may/may not be given to an earlier recipient based on his/her performance.

4. The performance of the Scholarship awarded candidates shall be monitored & evaluated by the Institute at the end of the year.

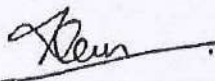
5. This agreement, unless extended by the written consent of the Donor, shall expire in FIVE years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph.
